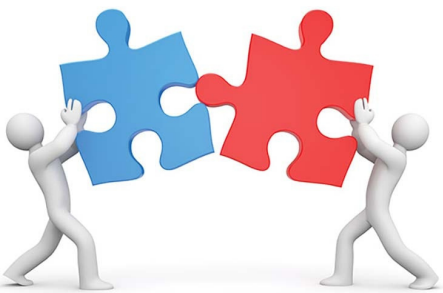

- Engaged over 2500 people through Collaborative and Campus events



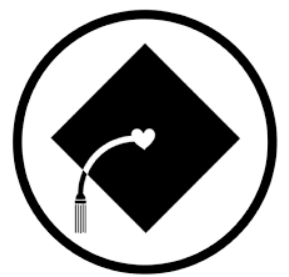
